Dr. YSR Smruthi Vanam near Nallakalva village, Atmakur mandal of Kurnool district, the only memorial shrine of the former Chief Minister coming up from among the proposed three, is fast nearing completion. It will be done before the third death anniversary of the former Chief Minister on September 2.

A majestic memorial park with a 20 ft statue of YSR made by sculptor Shivaprasad with his trademark raised hand waving to people with landscaping forms the main component, outside the forest and on the Nandyal-Atmakur road.

Theme gardens like neem – a personal favourite of YSR, fragrance garden, 'pavitra vanam' of 108 sacred plants, butterfly shaped garden with 150 species of carefully chosen plants to attract butterflies, fragrance garden, cafeteria, etc., are in the final stages at the site, a four-hour drive from here (300 kilometres).

III B.Sc Students and Staff, SML GDC Yemmiganur

Mahanandi is a small temple located in the district of Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh is a shivaite pilgrimage center which attracts thousands of visitors all around the year. This place is famous for the Mahanandishwara Temple of Lord Shiva. Mahanandi village is surrounded by green forest and has nine Nandi temples in its vicinity, Mahanandiswara Swamy Temple being one of them. The nine Nandi temples are as follows “Mahanandi, Shivanandi, Vinayakanani, Somanandi, Prathamnandi, Garudanandi, Suryanandi, Krishnanandi and Naganandi”. The Mahanandi Temple is 1500 years old and the “Maha Shivaratri” is celebrated in grandeur in the month of February and March.

The original shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva dates back to 7th century. Though, several remarkable additions to the temple has happened under the rule of various dynasties. The village of Mahanandi is surrounded by the dense forests of Nallamala hills and the Mahanandi temple is around 18 km from Nandyal town and 300 km from Hyderabad. This temple along with the other Nandi shrines located within the radius of 15km is known as the Nava Nandis. The main attractions here are the architecture and history of the temple, the remarkably crystal clear temple pools speculated to have healing qualities, and picturesque

surroundings. If you're looking for adventures beyond a visit to the temple, then this place may not be for you

Velugodu Reservoir is a balancing reservoir and located across the Galeru river [Kundu tributary](#) of [Penna river](#) at Velugodu town in [Kurnool district](#) of [Andhra Pradesh](#). This reservoir is part of [Telugu Ganga project](#) and mainly fed by gravity canal from back waters of [Srisaïlam Dam](#) through Pothireddypadu head / flow regulator located across the feeder canal. Velugodu Reservoir has gross storage capacity of 16.95 [Tmcft](#) at 265 m MSL full reservoir level.

This feeder canal called Srisaïlam right main canal (SRMC) also supplies water to [Chennai](#) city drinking water, Srisaïlam Right Bank Canal, [K. C. Canal](#) and

Galeru Nagari Canal in addition to divert the Krishna river flood water to Penna river for storage in [Somasila](#) and [Kandaluru](#) reservoirs situated in [Nellore district](#). The maximum flow capacity of the canal is 44,000 [cusecs](#) at full supply level of 267.92 metres (879 ft) [MSL](#)

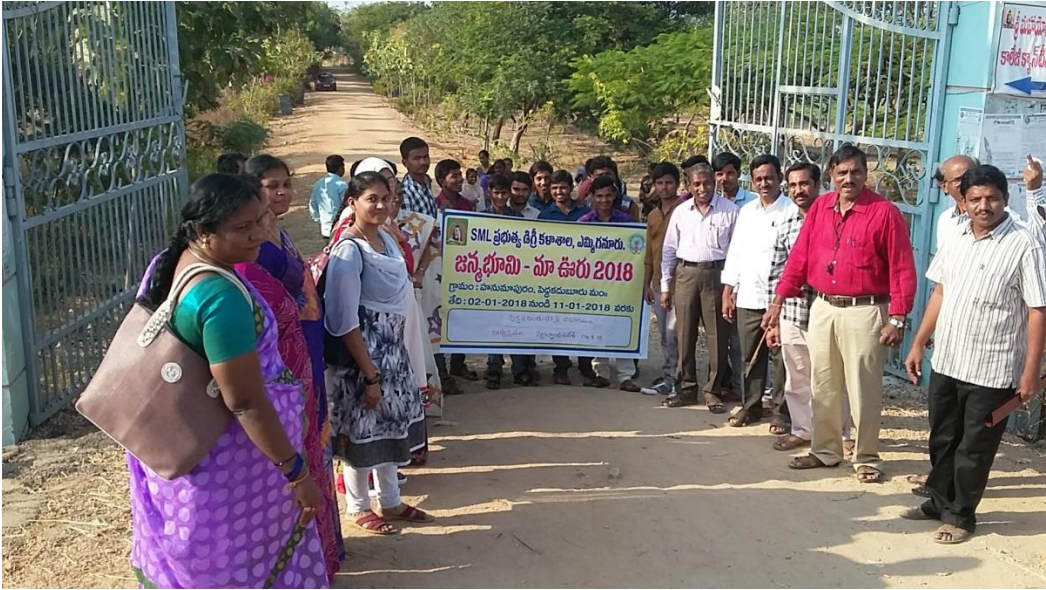

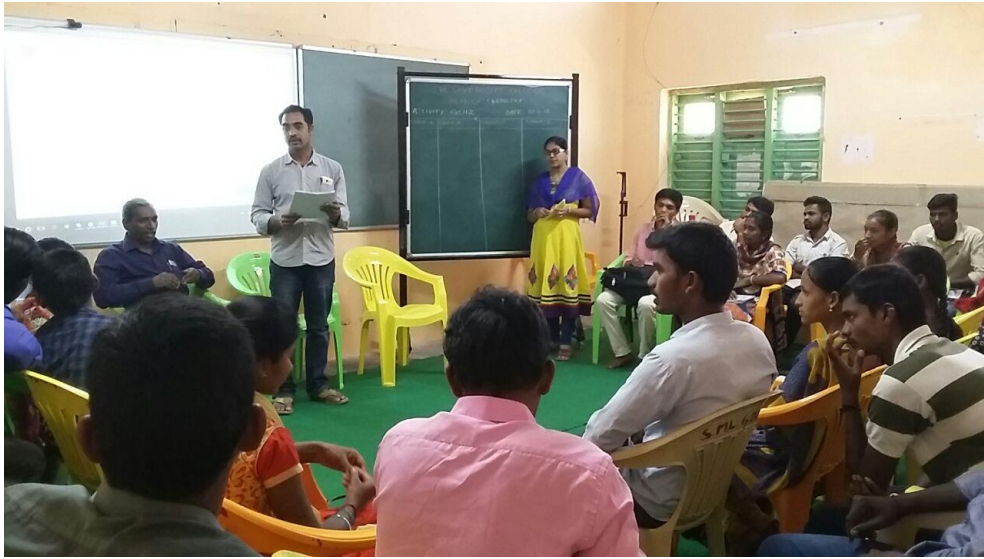

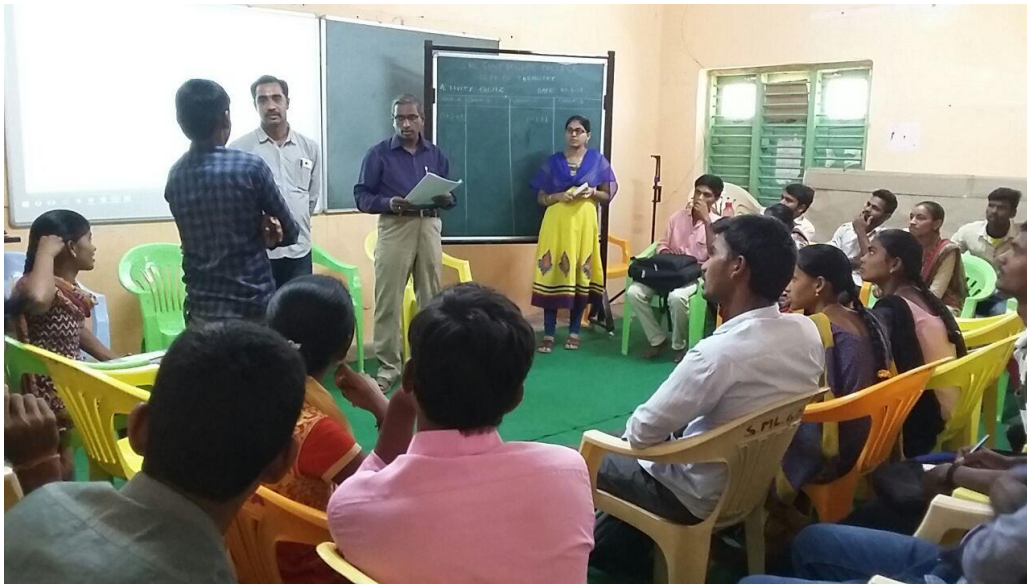

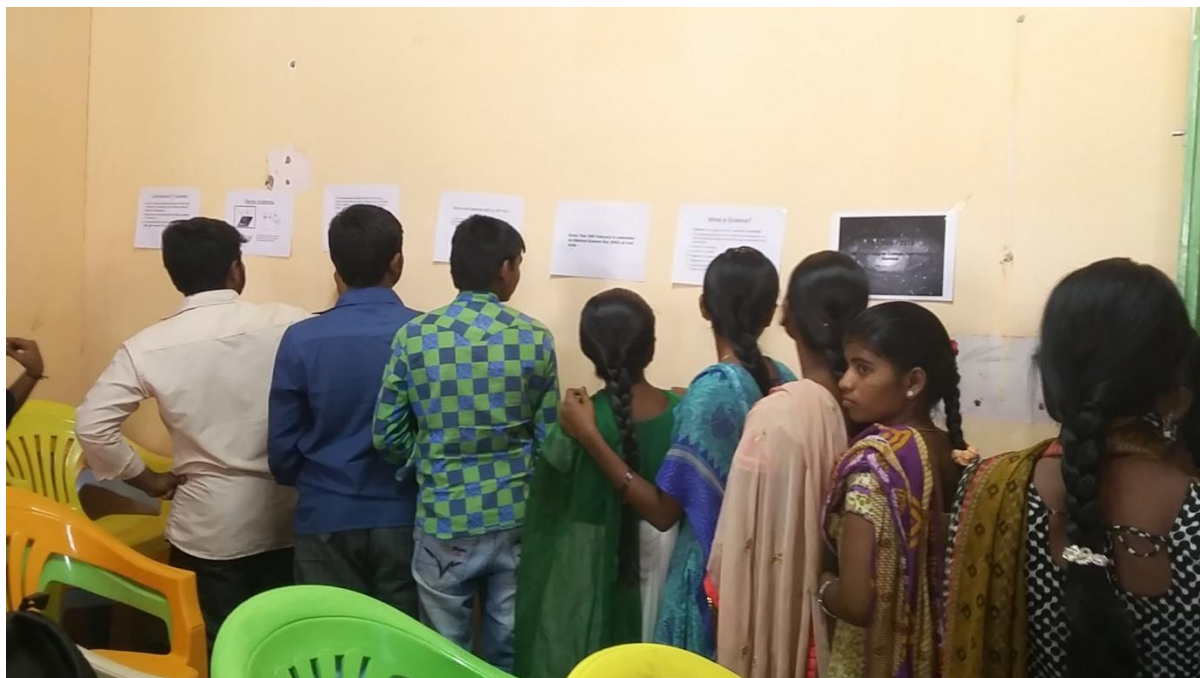
